



## YOUTH WORKER YOUTH BY THE PARK

Youth by the Park is a new youth provision run by St John's Church between October 2020 and March 2021, with the hope of being able to continue this provision longer term. A youth worker is required to help pioneer this project, building relationships with young people in the area and to assist with creating a youth provision that helps them to thrive. The role consists of both detached youth work and youth outreach; working on Victoria Park as well as running a youth club from St John's Church.

### **This role is subject to funding.**

The role is for 130 hours, paid at £10/hr.  
This is across 20 weeks, 6 hours a week, with an extra 10 hours to be used for training, team meetings, media or as required by the role.

The post is from 26<sup>th</sup> October – 31<sup>st</sup> March (start date dependent on the return of references and DBS. If the start date is to move later, the hours will remain the same and be redistributed.)

2 weeks off – Christmas w/c 21<sup>st</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> December

The youth worker is to report to the Kids and Youth Work Coordinator at Transform Widnes. The role holder will need to have an Enhanced-level DBS and provide two satisfactory references.

Duties include:

- To help with youth work on the park, to collect feedback from the young people on youth provision in the area and establish relationships, promoting the youth club.
- To help with the weekly running of the youth club. This includes planning, set up and pack down and interacting with the young people that attend, through conversations and activities.
- To work as part of a team of staff and volunteers to create a space where young people can thrive.
- To support the young people that attend through having conversations, identifying their needs and signposting as required.
- To be a role model to the young people, promoting positive and healthy life choices.
- To follow child protections procedures and report anything of concern to the designated safeguarding officer.

- To help advertise the youth provision to young people through direct conversations as well as communications with other services and through social media.
- To assist with media and marketing aspects of the youth provision such as logo design and content creation.
- To help collect feedback and review the provision, alongside a team, to ensure it is working towards the objectives and outcomes.
- To be an advocate of the youth club to others that want to know more about it.
- To attend training and team meetings as required.
- To complete other tasks, as necessary, that enhance the running of youth work from St John's Church.
